Maruku Arts

Nearly 700 artists make up the collective arts hub Maruku, which is owned and operated by the Anangu people from the Western and Central Deserts of Australia.

Maruku aims to keep the Anangu culture alive through art and also make their culture accessible with tours, painting and carving workshops, traditional ceremonies and art exhibitions.

Top End Day Tours

Run in collaboration with the Traditional Owners of Western Arnhem Land, Top End Day Tours are a journey into the heart of this region's beautiful wilderness. Join a Binninj guide to hear stories with strong connections to the landscapes. These tours offer cultural immersion in a spectacular setting.

Butchulla

Nestled along the pristine shores of K'gari, is a unique retreat managed by K'gari's original custodians, the Butchella people. This initiative not only offers a serene escape but also actively supports local Butchulla enterprises. By staying here on our tours, guests contribute to job creation and the development of culturally connected products like clap sticks, native art, and organic body washes. Moreover, funds help enhance the Scrub Hill cultural precinct and foster the growth of young Butchulla individuals. Collaborative efforts with the Butchulla also enrich visitor experiences, providing deep insights into their rich culture and history.


